## What courses are being offered for part-time study?

The following courses are accredited by the NSW Department of Education and Training. Each has 10 units of study.

- Year 1 of Bachelor of Divinity ([BD](#))
- Year 1 of Bachelor of Theology ([BTh](#))
- Diploma of Bible and Missions ([DipB&Miss](#))
- Diploma of Bible and Ministry ([DipB&Min](#))

## What can I do after I complete any of the above courses?

On successful completion of any of the above, you can progress to Year 2 of the four-year Bachelor of Divinity or the three-year Bachelor of Theology. Diploma students need Greek for progression.

## What does part-time study mean for me?

You can enrol in one or more units in any of the above courses.

If you wish to enrol in four or more units per semester please discuss this with the Dean of Part-time Students.

You can choose between day-time and evening classes. Two units are offered at night per semester.



## What do I need to enrol?

You need a degree from an Australian university or the equivalent. If you do not have a university degree, please inquire of the Registrar for alternate means of entry.
